Quote Description

Fencing

- Supply and install 0.86 km of 1800mm high kangaroo fencing.
- The requirement for a 1.8 metre high fence adds considerable time to complete installation as compared to a standard rural fence. The fencing crew is available to commence the work within the next 1 to 2 weeks. Completion will be before 30 June.
- The fencing alignment will roughly follow the existing fence line.
- An option for the GP Forestry fencing crew to remove the existing fence is offered in the quote.
- Some level of clearing vegetation from the alignments with a chainsaw will be required.
- Please see attached quote for fencing.

Ground Preparation

- A single shallow tyne line to a depth of around 300mm to be installed to assist with seedling planting and survival.
- The distance between the lines will be between 3 to 4 metres.
- The lines are to be installed in a random, wavy manner rather than straight.
- All machines to be clean on entry and exit to avoid the spread of *Phytophthora spp.*

Spraying

- Spray can be applied by either spot or short boom.
- Knock-down only to be applied – i.e. no residual herbicides.

Planting

- Planting within the fenced area does not require biodegradable tree guards (Green Guards). However a price to install guards has been provided in the quote.
- Please note that Green Guards take longer to assemble than plastic core flute guards this cost is reflected in the rate.
- Unguarded planting is a simple flat rate.

Site Management

- Professional site management and coordination by GP Forestry will oversee all aspects of the required works.

Delivery of Seedlings

- A delivery point for all seedlings to be stored and managed is required, the delivery point is expected to be nearby the operational area. The costs associated with the delivery of the seedlings from the nurseries to the location and the ongoing maintenance of the seedlings will be covered by GP Forestry.

Indigenous Engagement

- GP Forestry expects to engage their indigenous work force for part of the planting requirement.
