


2 Revegetation - accessible demonstration area for revegetation with higher value species incorporating explanatory signage and trees to improve riparian shading.

- 4 Existing cleared area near camping with few trees to be repurposed as firepit or barbeque area with adjacent picnic benches or shelters.
- 5 Marked area for day-parking with bollards or equivalent to prevent entry to foreshore and bush areas.
- 6 Enhanced existing facilities including improved toilets and additional picnic benches or shelters.
- 7 Modified vehicle access with clear definition of day-parking and camping areas. 8 Upgrades to principal information board to
- include historic and walk trail information. 9 New pedestrian bridge or boardwalk crossing
- to replace existing degraded bridge.
- 10 New pedestrian bridge providing connection to proposed footpath connection into townsite. 11 Trees for increased canopy and amenity.


