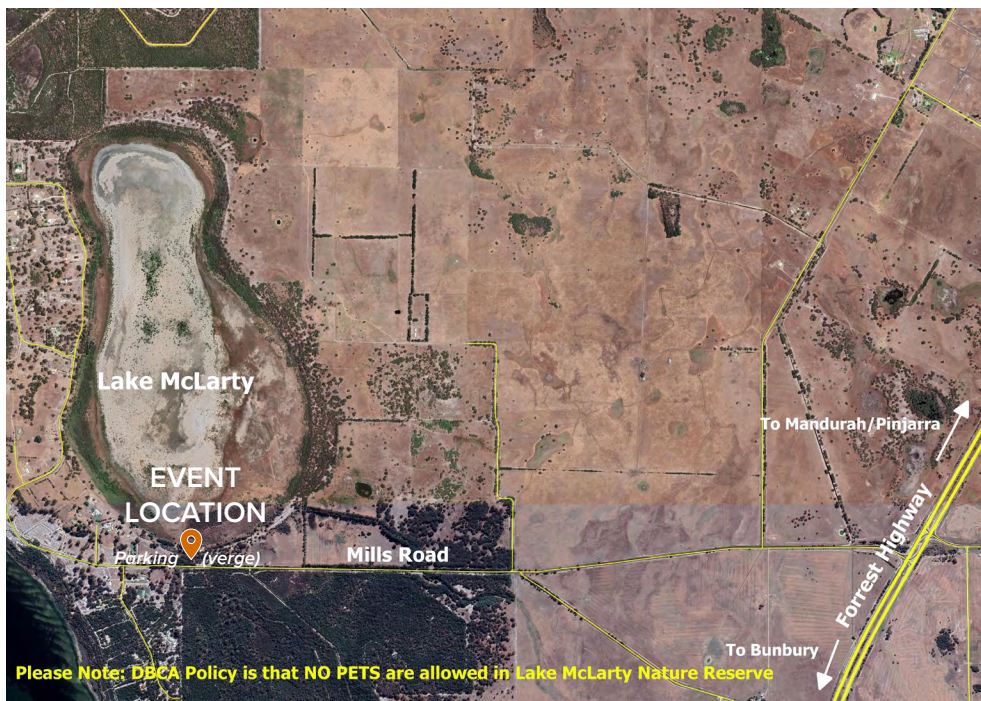
**Lake McLarty Nature Reserve** Mills Road, Birchmont
